We would also like to welcome our new member of staff to you all, Courtney who will be joining us on the 6th of December and working in our Explorer's room.

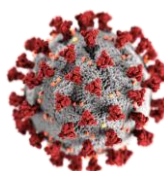


The deadline for the Elderly shoebox appeal is nearly upon us, if you would like to create a shoebox for this please may they be at nursery for Friday the 11th Of December
