Whilst settling in our new babies and younger children, our little explorers will be developing their senses through sensory investigation and messy play. Please can you ensure that they bring along spare clothing.

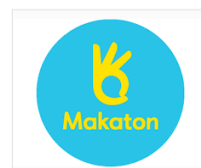
Clothing.

On Friday 30th September we say goodbye to Lois as she starts her maternity leave. We wish her lots of love as she prepares for her new little arrival

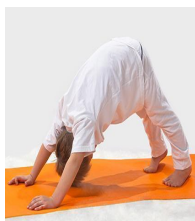


Diary Dates:
